

ORANGE JASMINE



The Orange Jasmine is an evergreen shrub from South-East Asia and Australia. It is also known as *Murraya Paniculata*. It produces fragrant, creamy white flowers in abundance in Spring then again in late Summer or early Autumn, and also after heavy rain. The Orange Jasmine has glossy green foliage and a dense, twiggy habit, which is often planted as a hedge or privacy screen. The *Murraya* can be grown in pots or in the garden.

Care: *Murrayas* prefer a sunny position in well-drained soil. To maintain a *Murraya* hedge prune lightly two to three times a year in Spring and Summer. Give a final prune in Autumn after flowering.

Flowering Season: They produce fragrant, creamy white flowers in abundance in Spring then again in late Summer or early Autumn.
